The conference provides an opportunity to participate in free discussion regarding the causes and mechanisms of injury, experimental methods and tools for use in impact biomechanics research, and the development of new concepts for reducing injuries and fatalities in automobile crashes.

This year's Stapp Conference will be held on November 7-9 at the Hyatt Regency in Dearborn, Michigan. Topics covered by technical presentations and published papers include research and developments concerned with injuries to motor-vehicle occupants and pedestrians, restraint system performance, advanced dummy design, modeling techniques, sports-related injuries, injuries in military environments, and crash avoidance technologies.
